## Sukkah Blessings

On entering the Sukkah:

בָרוּך אַתָּה יְיָ, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו וְצִוָּנוּ לֵישֵׁב בַּסֻּכָּה.

Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech Ha-olam, asher kidshanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu leishev ba-sukkah.

Praised are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the Universe, Who has made us holy by mitzvot and has instructed us to dwell in the sukkah.

On your first occasion in the sukkah during this Sukkot:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁהֶחֱיָנוּ וְקִיְמָנוּ וְהִגִּיעֵנוּ לַוְמֵן הַזֵּה.

Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech Ha-olam, shehecheyanu v'kiyemanu v'higianu la-zman ha-zeh.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the Universe, Who has granted us life, Who has sustained us, and Who has enabled us to reach this festive occasion.

Before eating:

בָּרוּך אַתָּה יְיָ, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, הַמּוֹצִיא לֶחֶם מִן הָאָרֶץ.

Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech Ha-olam, hamotzi lechem min ha-aretz.

Praised are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the Universe, Who brings forth bread from the earth.

Before waving the lulav and etrog:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אַשֵּׁר קִדִּשַׁנוּ בִּמִצִוֹתֵיו וִצְוַנוּ עַל נִטִילַת לוּלַב.

Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech Ha-olam, asher kidshanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu al n'tilat lulav.

Praised are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the Universe, Who has made us holy by mitzvot and has instructed us to take hold of the lulav.
