Sim Shalom is a musical prayer which we sing at the end of the Amida, asking God to give us peace, kindness and blessings.

Did you know?

The word "Shalom" has three meanings:

1. Hello!
2. Goodbye!
3. Peace!

In this prayer, it is meant as "peace".
