ገ፭ ፡ - Baruch She-amar is the first prayer in a series of blessings and psalms called: **Psukei Dezmira** (Verses of Praise).

When we pray, it is customary to praise God first, and only after that, we can pray for what we want or need. *Baruch She-amar* and other Verses of Praise appear at the beginning of the morning service, as a warm up for the rest of the service.

Praised is The One!

Praised is the One Who makes creation.

Praised is the One Who orders and fulfills promises

Praised is the One Who has compassion upon the world
