Big idea: from generation to generation...

לְדוֹר וָדוֹר (לְדוֹר L'dor Vador means "from generation to generation". This prayer says that from generation to generation we will praise God, and will declare God holiness.

This prayer is part of the *K'dusha*, which is the third part of the *Amida* prayer. The word *K'dusha* literally means "holiness".

Did you know?

In many B'nai Mitzvah services it is customary to pass the Torah from a grandparent, to a parent and then to the child who is celebrating becoming Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

This custom reminds us that the Torah and its teachings have passed on to us for thousands of years - many generations.
